

Annually, DMH typically has between 250 and 375 individuals who have been committed to DMH by the courts (criminal and civil). Of these individuals, approximately 10% are released from DMH's custody each year, meaning their order of hospitalization or order of non-hospitalization was not continued or renewed. As such we estimate approximately 25 - 38 individuals are released from custody from DMH each year.

Rep. Jewett – Per your question earlier this week, we estimate that approximately 115 individuals are committed to DMH each year through being found not guilty of a crime by reason of insanity or not competent to stand trial.
