2 The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred House Bill
3 No. 464 entitled “An act relating to the medical review process in the Reach
4 Up program and Postsecondary Education Program eligibility” respectfully
5 reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the report of the
6 Committee on Human Services be amended by striking out Sec. 11, effective
7 dates, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 11 and Sec. 12 to
8 read as follows:

9 Sec. 11. APPROPRIATION; INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY; REACH UP

10 In fiscal year 2023, \$500,000.00 is appropriated from the General Fund to
11 the Department for Children and Families to make improvements to the
12 Department’s information technology systems necessary to effect the changes
13 to the Reach Up program required pursuant to this act.

14 Sec. 12. EFFECTIVE DATES

15 This section and Sec. 11 (appropriation; information technology; Reach Up)
16 shall take effect on July 1, 2022. All other sections shall take effect on January
17 1, 2024, except that the Commissioner for Children and Families shall adopt
18 any rules necessary prior to that date in order to perform the Department’s
19 duties under this act.
