2 Representatives Arrison of Weathersfield, Austin of Colchester, Brady of
3 Williston, Brown of Richmond, Conlon of Cornwall, Cupoli of Rutland City,
4 Hooper of Randolph, James of Manchester, Toof of St. Albans Town, Webb of
5 Shelburne, and Williams of Granby move that the House concur in the Senate
6 proposal of amendment with further proposals of amendment as follows:

7 First: In Sec. 3, school facilities inventory and conditions assessment;
8 Agency of Education; Department of Buildings and General Services; report,
9 in subsection (a), by striking out “coordination” and inserting in lieu thereof
10 “consultation”

11 Second: In Sec. 10, State Energy Management Program; financing for
12 schools, by striking out “coordination” and inserting in lieu thereof
13 “consultation”

14 Third: In Sec. 12, radon testing; school facilities; Department of Health, in
15 the title, by striking out “; Department of Health”; by striking out subsection
16 (a) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

17 (a) On or before June 30, 2023, each public school and approved
18 independent school, as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11, shall perform a radon
19 measurement in accordance with the ANSI/AARST protocol for conducting
20 Radon and Radon Decay Products in Schools and Large Buildings (MALB-
21 2014) on any facility that has not had a test completed in five or more years;

1 provided, however, that any public school or approved independent school that
2 is engaged in implementing an indoor air quality improvement project prior to
3 June 30, 2023 shall perform a radon measurement on or before June 30, 2024.
4 and in subsection (b), by inserting “and approved independent school” after
5 “public school”
