



Fiscal Year 2018 (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018)


Total Revenue:

Grants Awarded in Fiscal Year 2018 (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018)


**Total Grants:

Grants Awarded in Fiscal Year 2018 (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018)


**Total Federal Grants:
