1. **Call to Order** The meeting was called to order at 9:02 a.m.
2. **Minutes** Ms. Trombly moved, seconded by Mr. Irwin, to approve the minutes of the October 20, 2022 meeting. Approved.

 - The Board generally supports the Counseling Compact and policies improving and addressing mobility and workforce issues. However, because of the diversity of state laws regarding mental health care, the Board has concerns with those provisions in the Counseling Compact requiring a member state to discipline a licensee following disciplinary action taken by another state's board against the licensee.Approved.
 - b. John Demos submitted a request asking for a waiver of Rule 3.27. Mr. Irwin moved, seconded by Ms. Trombly, to waive Rule 3.27 because, due to a significant medical event within his family, it would be manifestly unfair to refuse to consider his request to waive 20 of the 40 continuing education credits needed to renew his license for this current renewal cycle. Approved.
