2 Senator Campion moves that the bill be amended by striking out Sec. 4,  
3 16 V.S.A. § 45 (federal funds; data collection), in its entirety and inserting in  
4 lieu thereof the following:

5 Sec. 4. 16 V.S.A. § 45 is added to read:

6 § 45. FEDERAL FUNDS; DATA COLLECTION

7 (a) The Secretary of Education shall:

8 (1) define the term “student poverty” for the purposes of:

9 (A) determining qualification for federal funds by local education  
10 agencies, school districts, and schools;

11 (B) determining student eligibility for various educational programs  
12 and benefits where economic need is a consideration; and

13 (C) collecting and reporting disaggregated and student-level  
14 performance data as required;

15 (2) establish what student poverty data should be collected by local  
16 education agencies, school districts, and schools; the means by which the data  
17 should be collected; and the frequency of collection; and

18 (3) determine how this data shall be reported to the Agency of  
19 Education by local education agencies, school districts, and schools and the  
20 frequency of reporting.

- 1        (b) Local education agencies, school districts, and schools shall collect data
- 2        required under subdivision (a)(2) of this section and report this data to the
- 3        Agency of Education as required under subdivision (a)(3) of this section.
