**Gov. Shumlin Statement on Situation in Berlin**

**MONTPELIER** – Gov. Peter Shumlin issued the following statement on the developing situation in Berlin. The Governor plans to hold a press conference later this evening in the Montpelier area. Details to follow when available.

“The Vermont State Police are working collaboratively with the Barre and Berlin police and the investigation remains ongoing. Vermonters should know that there is no indication of a broader threat at this time to state employees or the general public. The tragedy that has gripped our state over the past 20 hours is immense. In the coming days we will need to pull together as a state to come to terms with these heinous events. My heart goes out to all the families, friends, and loved ones who have been affected by these tragedies.”
