We have received your public record act request dated November 10, 2014. You have asked for information reflecting the U.S. Government's jurisdiction over certain plots of land in Vermont. The Governor's Office is not the custodian of the records you seek, however, we hope the below information is helpful to you. We understand you have also contacted the Secretary of State's Office.

In addition to the Secretary of State's Office, you may wish to contact the town clerk's office of the town in which the land is located. More information about the recording of deeds or other conveyances to the U.S. Government is contained in the attached statutes from the legislature's website. These statutes also describe the consent of the State of Vermont to the U.S.

Government's acquisition by the United States over certain lands in Vermont. In addition, you may wish to contact the U.S. Attorney's Office regarding land in Vermont that is subject to federal jurisdiction or the Milwaukee Field Office of the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management-Eastern States.
