Not sure if you are point person for the state, but we are building on our experience with VT a year ago to create a crisis map for Sandy. We are now starting to get state specific data so we can build a layer that could include warnings, road closures and power outages (you know the drill). Is there someone on your team that could serve as point person? Sounds like power issues are going to be the most important. Fortunately, the map now works really well on mobile devices.

Let me know when you can if this would be useful. Pasting specific data requests below. Once I have a point person, we can assign someone from Google.

Here is a prioritized list of data we'd like from affected states :

- evacuation zones
- evacuation centers and shelter/relief resources
- utility outages
- transit outages
- evacuation routes
- road closures

We would like all of this data in KML and also need to get rights in place to use provided data. We've had some issues with FusionTables earlier today so KML is much preferred.

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
