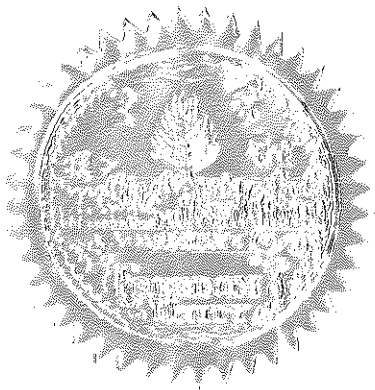
GREETINGS:
