Summary of House District Plan Attributes**

Statutory Criteria From 17 V.S.A. § 1903 [*Emphasis added*]

§ 1903. Periodic reapportionment; standards

(a) **The House of Representatives and the Senate shall be reapportioned and redistricted on the basis of population** during the biennial session after the taking of each decennial census of the United States...

(b) **The standard for creating districts** for the election of Representatives to the General Assembly **shall be to form representative districts with minimum percentages of deviation from the apportionment standard** for the House of Representatives... The representative... districts **shall be formed consistent with the following policies insofar as practicable:**

- (1) preservation of existing political subdivision lines;
- (2) recognition and maintenance of patterns of geography, social interaction, trade, political ties, and common interests;
- (3) use of compact and contiguous territory.
