Dear Governor:

Under the Vermont Public Records Law, S/315 et seq. I am requesting an opportunity to obtain copies of public records that pertain to email, written and oral communications between Governor Shumlin and Rutland City Mayor Christopher Louras from Sept. 1, 2015 to July 1, 2016 relating to the Vermont Refugee Resettlement Program and potential benefit to both the VRRP or the Mayor.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me. However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of the refugee resettlement issue. I am a Rutland City Alderman whose term expires in March of 2017. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes.

The law requires a response to this request within two (2) days, or within ten (10) days for extraordinary circumstances. If you expect a significant delay in fulfilling this request, please contact me with information about when I might expect copies of the requested records.

Email forwarding of the information requested is acceptable to me.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
