Bill Summary

The bill proposes changes to alcoholic beverage laws including, but not limited to, a provision to allow municipalities to charge a \$50 processing fee for stand-alone third class licenses, provisions pertaining to sale of alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption, and provisions pertaining to festival permits. The effective date would be July 1, 2021.

Fiscal Summary

The bill, as proposed by the House Committee on General, Housing and Military Affairs, is not estimated to have any substantive impact to State revenues or expenditures.
