



Comparison of Broadband Investments Under Current Law  
and as Proposed Under H.513  
April 25, 2019

Sections 4 and 5 of H.513 as passed by the House require that High-Cost Fund and Connectivity Initiative grants be awarded for projects that provide minimum broadband speeds of 25 Mbps/3Mbps.

The charts below compare the number of customers served and the cost per address for recent Consolidated Communication projects with the number served and cost per address under H.513.
