**Lt. Governor to work as a soldier with the Vermont National Guard**

Lt. Governor Phil Scott continues his “Vermont Everyday Jobs Tour” on Saturday, January 11, when he will participate in drill and training exercises with the Vermont National Guard. The Lt. Governor will be integrated as a soldier, outfitted with a uniform, and sent out to perform a variety of tasks with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion 172<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Regiment. In this “Everyday Job,” Lt. Gov. Scott will work with gunners, mechanics, company RTOs and mission command, performing the same tasks as Vermont National Guard soldiers. On Sunday, these soldiers will be honored at a ceremony during which the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion will receive the Valorous Unit Award for its service in Afghanistan. That ceremony will take place at the Shapiro Field House at Norwich University, Northfield.
