To Scott Coriell:

Pursuant to Vermont's Public Records Act, 1 V.S.A. 315-320, I hereby request copies of documents related to Russian malware at Burlington Electric Department. In particular, I am looking for all communication received or sent by (or on behalf of) Gov. Peter Shumlin regarding the malware as well as any correspondence discussing possible hacks or interference into other city or state utilities.

I make this request on behalf of Seven Days newspaper.

If you believe that we not entitled to some of these records, please let me know within three business days, as required by Vt. Stat. Ann. tit. 1, § 318(a)(2), and inform us of the specific exemption that you believe applies to each record or portion of a record being withheld. If an otherwise public record has a portion that is exempt from disclosure, we request that you block out the exempt portion and release a copy of the rest of the record together with a notation identifying the specific exemption that you believe applies to the portion withheld.

If some or all of our request is denied, please notify us of the title and name of the person responsible for the denial, and please inform us of the appeal procedures available to us, including the name of the person to whom appeal may be made.
