Sec. X. ROAD RULE; WASTEWATER AND POTABLE WATER SUPPLY APPLICATION FORMS

(a) On or before [effective date], the Natural Resources Board shall adopt guidance on how to calculate the length of road that creates jurisdiction under 10 V.S.A. § 6001(3)(A)(xii).

(b) On or before [effective date] the Secretary shall amend the application forms for permits issued pursuant to 10 V.S.A. chapter 64 so that a person applying for a new subdivision, wastewater system, or potable water supply shall provide the total length of any road in accordance with guidance adopted by the Natural Resources Board. The Secretary shall include the total length provided by an applicant in a permit issued for a new subdivision, wastewater system or potable water supply. This length shall be for informational purposes only and the Secretary shall not be required to validate the length of the road as a part of the review of a permit under 10 V.S.A. chapter 64.

Note: The current effective date of the Senate's proposal of amendment to H.926 is 7/1/2020.
