Dear Robin,

The following is a public records request, pursuant to 1 V.S.A. sec 315 et seq. Vermont Public Radio requests, from Jan. 1 2014 to the present, all documents and communications related to:

- The development of a financing plan for a publicly funded health care system;
- Modeling related to a financing plan for a publicly funded health care system;
- The financial viability of a publicly funded health care system;
- Federal Affordable Care Act waiver funding
- Any alternatives to a publicly funded health care system; and
- Political issues or considerations involving a publicly funded health care system

For the purposes of this request, "communications" means: communication in any form or medium, including oral, telephonic, written, email and electronic communications. "Document" means: any public record or public document, as defined in 1 V.S.A. sec. 317(b), and includes correspondence, letter, paper, record or file kept in any medium, including hard copies, paper copies, all electronic media, and all mail communications.

If any part of these requests is denied, please list the specific criteria you are relying on for the denial.

If you claim that any document or communication is exempt from this request due to an exemption in public records law, or any alleged privilege, please identify which documents you claim are exempt, and

specify the exemption or privilege you think applies.
