Capitol Complex Security Working Group
Security Enhancement Recommendations

The Capital Complex Security Working Group recommends the following security enhancements in the Capitol Complex to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Institutions:

1. Develop a policy on data access and retention for cameras.
2. Install cameras focused only on points of ingress. These should be fixed cameras (meaning they do not pan, tilt or zoom) that are positioned to identify individuals entering through each point of ingress to the State House.
3. Direct the Sergeant at Arms to continue training and security exercises.
4. Upgrade access control at points of ingress at the State House, including the ability to remotely lock doors.
