Hi Senator Ashe,

I wanted to let you know that Connecticut issued a draft decision on the REC/SPEED issue today. On page 11 you can see bullet 6 and the conclusion paragraph that indicates that they believe the legislative effort underway in Vermont would make our program compatible with the region, and that they are holding off on deciding if there is a double counting claim in 2017 related to SPEED, at least in part because of the legislation pending.

We believe this is all consistent with our testimony to legislative committees that we believed there may be an issue for 2017, and that the energy proposal embodied in H.40/S.51 would resolve that problem.
