Hi Loring – I understand that this may be taken up today at 10 or possibly tomorrow 9 to 9:30.

The Board of Medical Practice supports H.690 as an appropriate amendment of the statutes to allow physicians to use acupuncture in their practice without obtaining a separate acupuncture license. The Board asks the Committee to consider adding physician assistants licensed under chapter 33 of this [26 V.S.A.] title. Acupuncture is a medical task that could be delegated by a physician to a qualified physician assistant.

I could call in today, if that might be acceptable to the Committee.

I have a meeting in Montpelier tomorrow and could come by to testify in person between 9 and 9:30, or preferably earlier if there is any chance that the Committee might convene earlier.
