in this State to make annual returns of the
number of their paupers in their Respective
Towns &c. Therefore we state the number of
Paupers constantly supported are Five
The manner of supporting is by disposing of
at the lowest bidder all who are at an annual
-al expence and the residue at the discretion
of the Overseers of the Poor, the whole expence
\$260.- The causes which probably reduced
them to pauperism
