Dear Major General Cray,

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Vermont and Commander-in-Chief, Vermont National Guard, by the Constitution and laws of the State of Vermont, including Chapter II, Section 20 of the Vermont Constitution and 20 V.S.A. § 366, and having determined that the necessity of public service requires it, I hereby direct you to designate [up to 90] National Guard personnel for the performance of state active duty for the purpose of responding to and providing support to Vermont Emergency Management's requests for military support related to [flooding, threats of flooding, and severe weather] [in Chittenden, Lamoille, and Washington counties].

Pay for personnel performing the above-described service shall be in accordance with 20 V.S.A. § 603.

This order will take effect immediately.
