MARCH 17, 2022 – REMOTE MEETING

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:02 a.m.

 - a. Antioch DMT MOU – The Board will review and make a formal decision on approval of this MOU at its April meeting.
4. Applications

Ms. Smith moved, seconded by Ms. Austin, to approve actions taken by the Board in the following applications:

Belcher Alexandra - Endorsement from Alabama. The Board found that the standards and qualifications for licensure in Alabama are not substantially equivalent to Vermont's standards and qualifications for licensure because Alabama does not require 3000 hours of post-degree supervised practice and only requires the passage of one examination. The Board determined that the applicant is not eligible for licensure based on endorsement from another state. The applicant may apply on the basis of examination, or, since she will be licensed in Alabama for three years come May 28th, 2022, she can reapply at that time under the 3-year, fast-track endorsement basis.

Bowman, Katie – The Board has decided to preliminarily deny her application due to failure to meet the coursework requirements for licensure established in the Rules.

Gajowski, Carrie – MFT – The Board reviewed her application on the basis of examination. The Board needs course descriptions and/or syllabi before they can determine whether the applicant meets the coursework requirements for licensure.

Garcilazo, Griselda – The Board needs additional information.

Milord-Aianma, Marie – The Board needs additional information.

Sangrey, Aylssa – Approved for licensure on the basis of endorsement from New York.
Both examinations have been successfully completed.
