I have had a draft of a "clean up" EO that would rescind various executive orders of prior administrations that are obsolete. I have been wondering about rescinding the below executive order, as I have assumed that its major (legal) purposes are accomplished elsewhere, including in the statutes below. I believe Pat ultimately felt it was ok to revoke this order as sections of it are out of date, though this was with some trepidation given the interests in this area. Regardless, I want to ensure that you/ your general counsel agree this order can or should be revoked at this point if it is in fact obsolete.
