


Q10 Prison Closure: What would you like the municipal message to the legislature to be regarding the use of the prison facility? (The land outside the fence is already being managed by the Dept. of Fish and Wildlife) Any repurposing needs to be approved and funded by the legislature. Most of the farm buildings are in poor condition but many of the administrative buildings are in good condition. The property has a new water supply system, municipal sewer, solar arrays that reduce electric cost to the facility and new greenhouses.
