Hey Bill, we are going to invoke the 10 day rule for the Brock request. I'll be able to provide a list of names where we know some form of compensation was provided after June 2010 later this week. (I do not think you will have corollary records for most settlements.)

Susanne Young is spearheading the AGO response, and I believe she is coordinating with civil. I am working on the DHR response, which has significant AGO cross over, but is broader. The monetary settlements are comparatively manageable--Senator Brock's remaining requests are not.

As for the Digger request, DHR does not have an effective way to respond. Essentially, we would have to review all stipulations that have been alphabetically filed for many years, cull the smaller number that involve compensation, and then redact any personal information in the settlement agreements and provide it. (Often, the monetary value would not be clear without doing further research.) I am hoping risk management's database is more user friendly. Can you provide the information you have relatively easily? The recipient's identity and settlement amounts are public. Additional information--including the identity of other employees and a claim's procedural posture--has to be evaluated.
