2 The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill
3 No. 206 entitled “An act relating to planning and support for individuals and
4 families impacted by Alzheimer’s Disease and related disorders” respectfully
5 reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the House propose
6 to the Senate that the bill be amended by striking out Sec. 5 in its entirety and
7 inserting a new Sec.⁵_^ to read as follows:

8 Sec. 5. ALZHEIMER’S DISEASE COORDINATOR

9 On or before December 15, 2022, the Agency of Human Services shall
10 submit a plan to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare and to the
11 House Committee on Human Services to fund, within existing budgets, grants,
12 or other external funding sources, a permanent Alzheimer’s Disease
13 Coordinator position to be shared between the Departments of Health and of
14 Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living for the purpose of planning, public
15 education, and coordination as informed by the recommendations of the
16 Commission on Alzheimer’s and Related Disorders established pursuant to
17 3 V.S.A. § 3085b, the State Plan on Aging required pursuant to 33 V.S.A.
18 § 6206, and other relevant statewide plans on Alzheimer’s disease and related
19 disorders.
