Dear Mr. Secretary:

Pursuant to Article II, Section 73 of the Vermont Constitution and Section 1906 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated (as amended by Act 11 (2021)), as Chair of the Legislative Apportionment Board I am filing herewith the Board's proposed plan for reapportionment of the Senate. The plan consists of a map showing the proposed new Senate district boundaries.

Owing to delays caused by the U.S. Census Bureau's late delivery of the final census data and the effects of meeting and working during a pandemic, the Board regrets that it was unable to complete its full written report at this time. The Board will supplement the proposed new Senate district map with a written analysis and narrative, to be filed in the next 20 days.

The Apportionment Board's website contains substantial additional resources that we hope will be useful to the Senate, including alternative maps and spreadsheets.
