2 Senator Lyons moves that the Senate concur in the House proposal of  
3 amendment to the Senate proposal of amendment to the House proposal of  
4 amendment with further proposals of amendment as follows:

5 First: By striking out Sec. 4a, Green Mountain Care Board; ambulatory  
6 surgical center reporting requirements; prospective repeal, in its entirety and  
7 inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 4a to read as follows:

8 Sec. 4a. AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTER REPORTING;  
9 APPLICABILITY; PROSPECTIVE REPEAL

10 (a) 18 V.S.A. § 9375(b)(14) (Green Mountain Care Board; ambulatory  
11 surgical center reporting requirements) is repealed on January 16, 2026.

12 (b) The information to be reported by the Green Mountain Care Board  
13 pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 9375(b)(14)(B) shall be included beginning with the  
14 Board’s 2021 annual report.

15 (c) Notwithstanding any provision of 18 V.S.A. § 9375(b)(14) or this  
16 section to the contrary, following submission of its 2023 annual report, the  
17 Green Mountain Care Board shall not be required to collect, review, or report  
18 further data regarding an ambulatory surgical center that was in operation on  
19 January 1, 2019.

20 Second: In Sec. 6, effective dates, by striking out subsection (c) in its  
21 entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (c) to read as follows:

- 1        (c) Secs. 3a (18 V.S.A. § 9373), 4 (18 V.S.A. § 9375(b)), and 4a
- 2        (ambulatory surgical center reporting; applicability; prospective repeal) and
- 3        this section shall take effect on passage.
