29th. A.D. 1828

The number of paupers supported wholly  
by the Town the year past, is three

The number supported in part as above is  
three

The manner of supporting them was, the  
expense was sold to the lowest bidder - Expense \$187.50.

The cause of pauperism not assignable  
Expense incurred in determining the residence of  
a stranger, and administering to his necessities when  
sick \$16.50

The above items of expense are exclusive of  
Overseers fees
