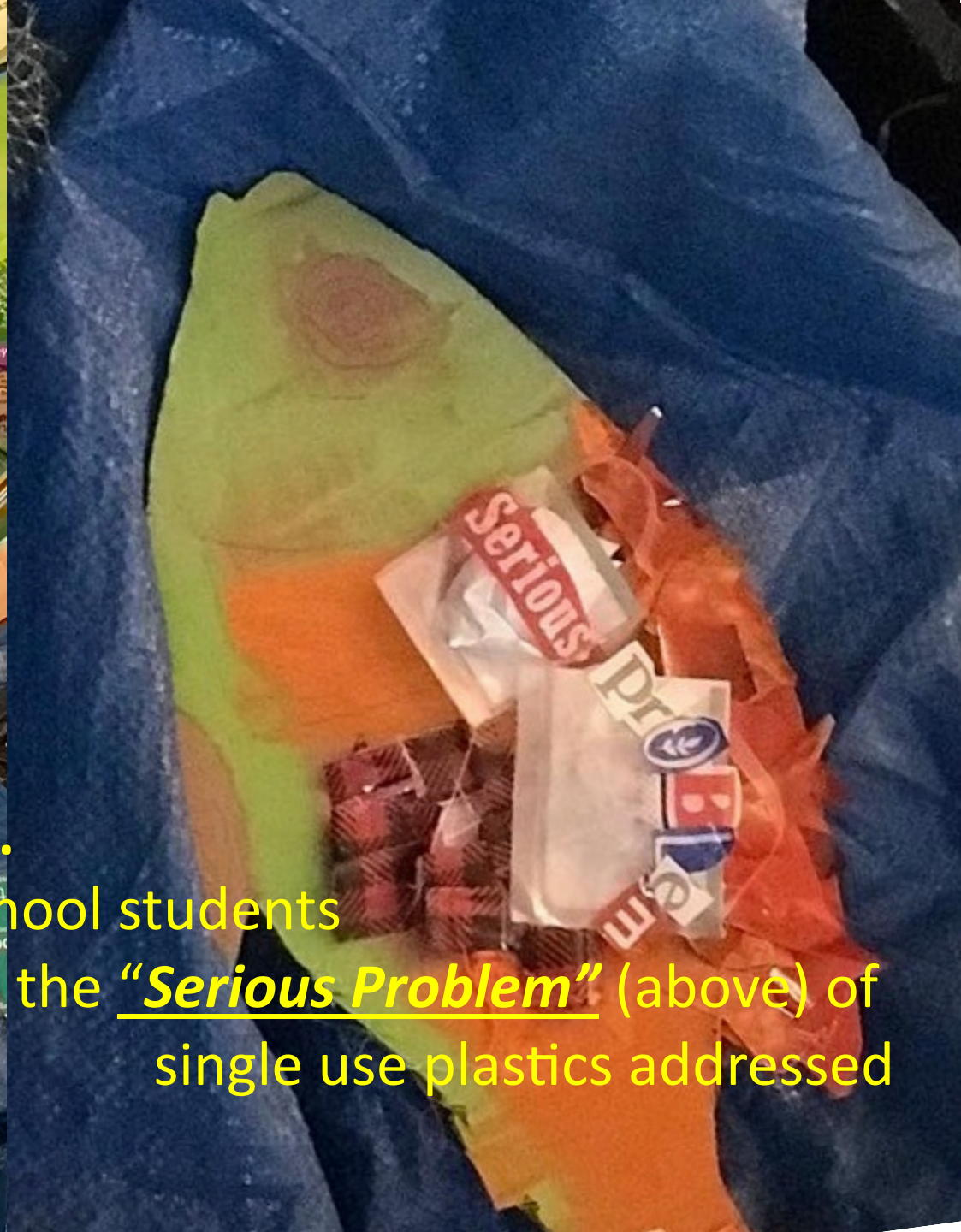

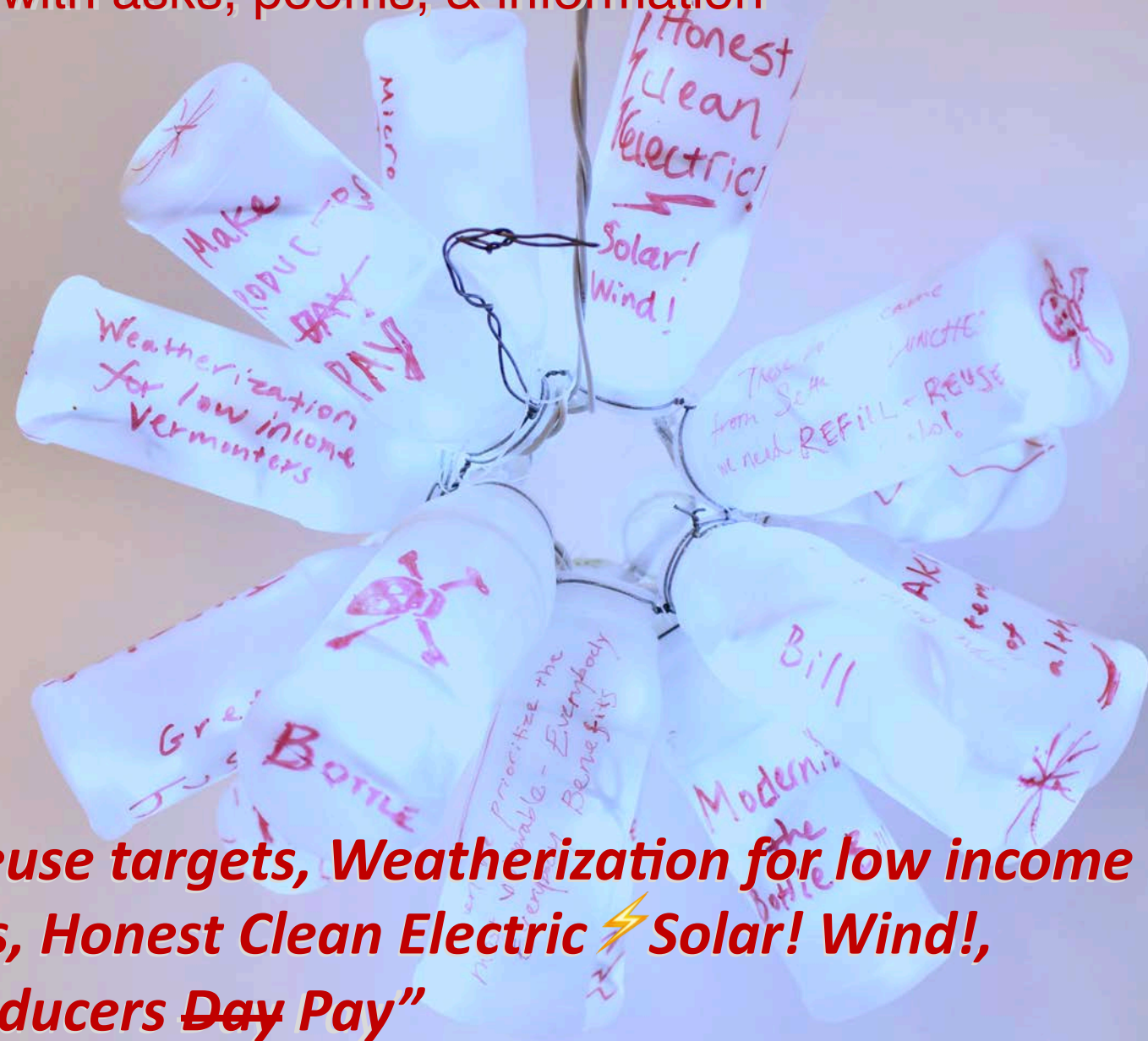

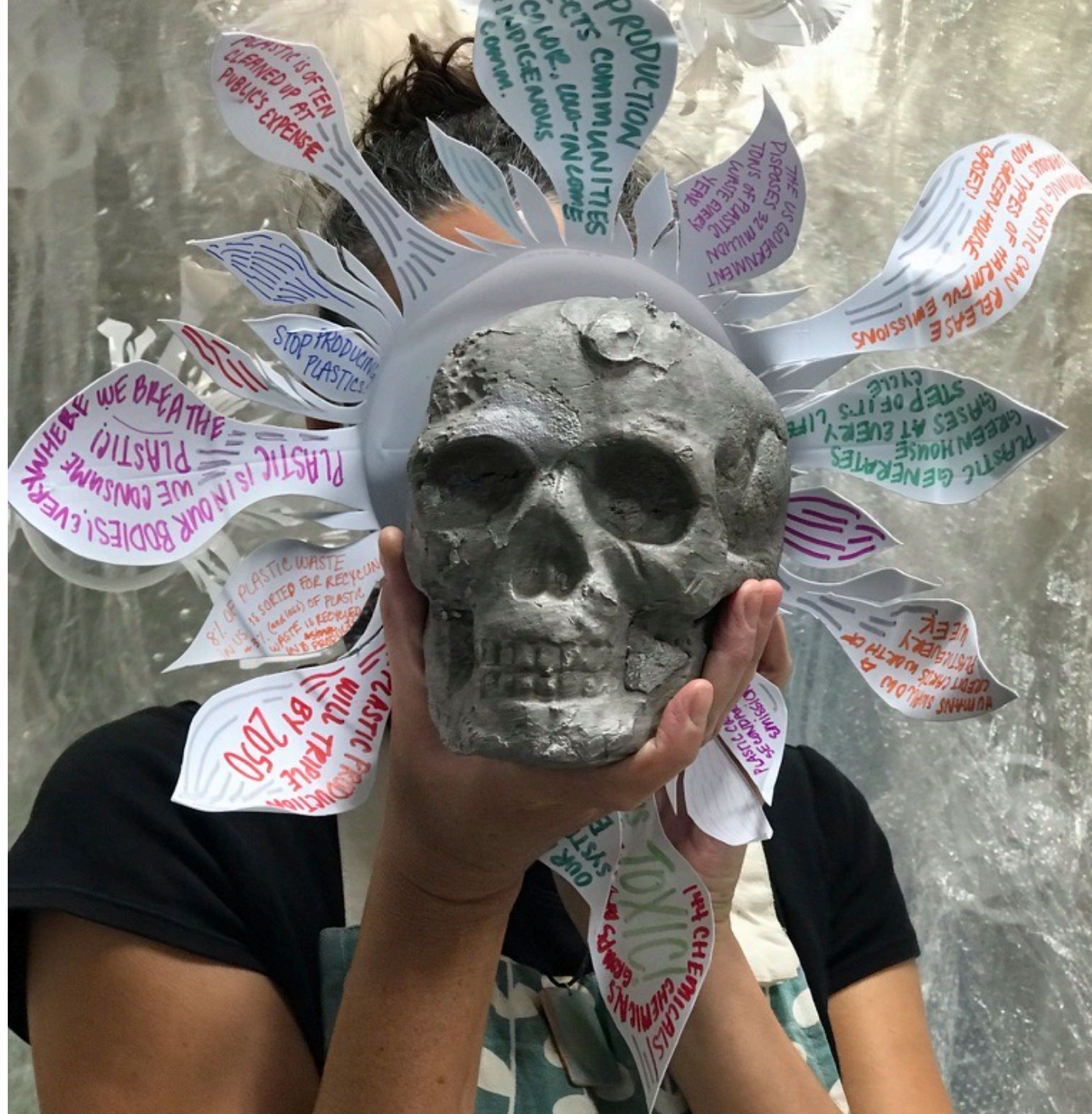

“Plastic Production will triple by 2050” if we allow this to continue
Plastics are releasing harmful emissions & toxins at every stage of their short lives – where we make them, use them – at home & work, & where we dispose of them.



“Plastic production affects communities of color, low-income + indigenous communities.”

Most plastics are produced in this country in Black communities – effecting health so much that the main area of plastic production in Louisiana is now called Cancer Alley. Plastics are often disposed overseas. Our one Vermont landfill is filling up with single use plastics. **40% + of all our Vermont trash is single use.**



On January 8TH around 45 people came out as a “Sea Change for Climate” to show the statehouse being “flooded” with messages of concern, support & love for climate justice now.

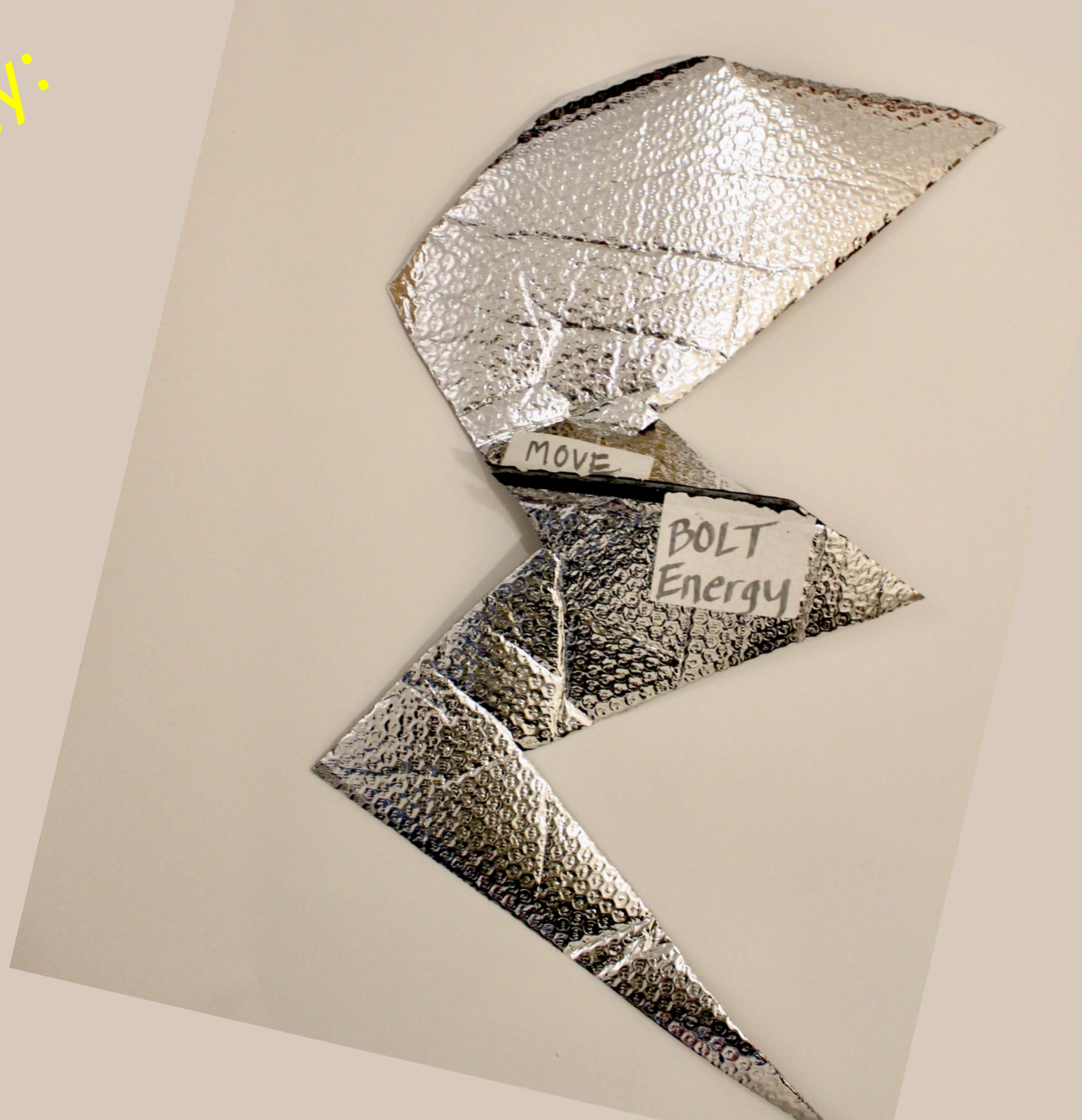
