Thanks very much for the response.

I guess I have to file an appeal because your office has failed to provide the public records requested in my emails. (It is a little hard to file an appeal until the public records requested are provided by your office and can be reviewed to determine if they comply.)

I requested the actual pardons forms that were filled out and submitted through the Governor's website and also in any other form of record/communication.

The personal information you mention may cover social security numbers, but not much else. Under the law you must provide the record/document and are free to redact personal information (like social security numbers. Contact information is debatable.)

Again this response does not comply with the requests under Vermont's Public Records Law that I have filled.

Thanks. I await the public records requested. Otherwise, please consider this an appeal.
