1. The meeting was called to order at 1:32pm.
2. Added to the agenda was the discussion of the National Board and Federation meeting that Dr. Sommers attended virtually. The meeting was about expanding and adopting the PACE program and increasing accessibility to testing by adopting more digital solutions.
3. Added to the agenda was the discussion regarding the NBCE allowing state representatives to participate in their part 4 exam administration on May 21. Dr. Temple was nominated as Vermont's delegate by Dr. McDaniel, seconded by Dr. Sommers. Motion passed.
