

### Gannon Amendment to S.54

- Requires the Governor to submit to the Cannabis Control Board Nominating Committee at least five names per vacancy.
- Increases the square footage for the designation of “small cultivator” from 500 sq ft to 1,000 sq ft.
- Requires the Department of Health to develop the health warnings concerning cannabis that will be adopted by the Board.
- Reduces the maximum amount of THC that may be in a cannabis product from 100 mg to 50 mg.
- Amends the reporting requirement for the Department of Public Safety regarding a threshold THC level to establish impairment and approving a chemical testing device for roadside use so that the report is not dependent on findings by the National Traffic Highway Safety Association.
- Directs that, while the Board should consider accommodations for small cultivators where appropriate, small cultivators must comply with the land use and environmental standards required by the Act.
- Clarifies that the U.S. EPA worker protection standards for pesticide use would apply to cannabis cultivation and the handling of pesticides for production of cannabis products.
- Makes small tweaks to language to prevent the Board from deviating, weakening, or lessening the scope or strength of environmental or pesticide laws.
