Senate Resolution

S.R. YY. Senate resolution relating to the suspension of Senator Norman H. McAllister.

Whereas, Senator Norman H. McAllister has been charged with sexual assault and prohibited acts, and a court of competent jurisdiction has found probable cause against him, and

Whereas, if the Vermont Senate institutes expulsion proceeds with these criminal charges pending, protections provided by the United States Constitution, Vermont Constitution and Vermont Statutes and Rules may be compromised, now therefore be it

Resolved by the Senate:

That, as the institution of expulsion proceedings during the pendency of the criminal charges may prejudice the outcome of the criminal proceedings, the Senate hereby suspends Senator Norman H. McAllister from exercising any of the powers of his office as a Member of the Senate until all criminal proceedings currently pending against him have been dismissed.
