UNAPPROVED MINUTES OF
AUGUST 2, 2016 MEETING

1. The meeting was called to order at 1:33 p.m.
2. The minutes of the March 8, 2016 meeting were approved as written.
3. Case Managers Report – There are 4 cases pending. 2 cases have been recommended for closure, 1 case is under investigation and 1 case is pending charges.

The Board asked if a complaint came in on a chiropractor regarding ionizing radiation which board would it come to, the Chiropractic Board or the Board of Radiologic Technology. Ms. Preston stated that it would go to both.

- b. Dr. Temple updated the Board on his discussion with the Board of Radiologic Technology. The Board of Radiologic Technology is currently working on a course with UVM to meet this requirement in the future.

At this time there are 21 out of 81 chiropractors who have ionizing radiation privileges that have submitted the application to the Board of Radiologic Technology to be licensed. If one wishes to continuing being able to apply ionizing radiation they must, by September 30, 2016, have applied to the Board of Radiologic Technology for this privilege. If they have not, as of October 1, 2016 this will become inactive. The Board has asked that the renewal that will be emailed to licensees in mid-August, include a section to remind chiropractors with this privilege to be sure they comply with the new regulation.

The proposed rules of the Board of Radiologic Technology will be posted on its website in the very near future. There will be a comment period and a proposed rules hearing will be scheduled.
