I have to get this to Gov as there has been some confusion on this point. Any additions?

Declaring a state of emergency permits the Governor to make use of a number of emergency powers that aren't otherwise available, including things like ordering evacuations, issuing emergency permits and waivers of certain requirements related to electricity and natural gas, and taking control of our fuel supply and means of transportation if necessary. Declaring a state of emergency also helps protect the public because certain consumer protection laws apply with special force in a state of emergency -- like pricing gouging of critical products like generators or gasoline is especially suspect in a declared state of emergency. Declaring a state of emergency can also help lay the ground work for FEMA support and calling out the National Guard if necessary.
