Wheels for Warmth tire collection begins in Montpelier and Williston

Lt. Governor Phil Scott announces that the Wheels for Warmth tire collection centers in Montpelier and Williston open for drop-offs today in advance of Saturday's ninth annual sale. Those two locations are:

- Dubois Construction, 46 Three Mile Bridge Road, Montpelier, and
- Casella Waste Management, 28 Avenue C, Williston

Tires will be accepted and inspected at both of these locations on Thursday, Oct. 24, and Friday, Oct. 25, from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m. Car and truck tires will be accepted for resale at no charge if they meet inspection criteria. All tires will be accepted for recycling at a charge of \$4/tire.

The ninth annual Wheels for Warmth tire sale is on Saturday from 7 a.m. – 1 p.m. at Dubois Construction in Montpelier. Tire donations will also be accepted at this location only during that time.

Since the program began in 2005, Wheels for Warmth has raised more than \$178,000 for emergency fuel assistance, sold nearly 10,000 safe donated tires, and recycled almost 16,000 unsafe, unusable tires. For more information, please visit www.wheelsforwarmth.com.
