Analysis of Bill

1. **Summary of bill and issue it addresses.** *This bill will allow all ATVs registered in their own state to be recognized as registered in Vermont even if the other state does not recognize VT in the same way.*
2. **Is there a need for this bill?** **Yes, this allows persons to come to VT for this type of recreation if they are registered only. It allows more people to come to VT that may not have before**
3. **What are likely to be the fiscal and programmatic implications of this bill for this Department?** **None**
4. **What might be the fiscal and programmatic implications of this bill for other departments in state government, and what is likely to be their perspective on it?** **More people may come to VT for the purpose of recreation. This will boost tourism**
