I spoke with Tom Beattie of the Diamond Hill Store and explained to him where we are in the process. I explained the process for getting the contractor on board and that we'd be getting a construction schedule from them after they've been awarded the contract. I offered to meet with him now or after we have a contractor and a schedule, and he chose the latter. This makes the most sense, as his concerns are related to how and how long the construction will be in front of his business, which we (VTrans) can't tell him without the contractor.

Once the contractor is on board I will coordinate with Chris to meet with Tom. I suspect Chris will likely meet with most of the affected property owners at one time or another and won't need me to participate, but this one is special, as they currently have a compensation appeal in the courts.
