A return of the overseers of the poor of the Town of Ludlow,  
to the Secretary of State, of the number of paupers in said Town,  
the number & expense of supporting the same. together with  
the causes of their pauperism & the number of law suits, with  
the expenses thereof for the year ending on the second Monday  
of March A.D. 1829.

The number of paupers in said town were  
Sixty, who were disposed of at our annual March  
meeting to the lowest bidders. — The causes of the pauperism  
of Town, were three, infirmities of old age, & two, noncompas-  
sion. — The expense of their support about \$200.00. —  
No expense in law suits. —
