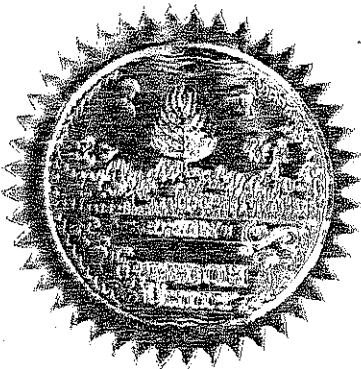
GREETINGS:
