- 1) Put Paper ballots into statute -always and forever
- 2) Voter ID required
 - a. Provisions for universal access to photo ID
 - b. Provisions for various evidences of ID (not just birth certificate – could include SS Card)
- 3) Same-Day voters get provisional ballots
- 4) Require witness on envelope for ABS ballot return
- 5) Require bipartisan appointees for BCA (negating land-slide elections)
- 6) Universal request forms – not universal ballots
- 7) Clearer Residency requirements
- 8) Absentee deadline = in-person deadline
- 9) Reporting of total ballots cast when polls close
- 10) Address delivery of mailed ballots to nursing homes & assisted living centers (mail handled by staff)
- 11) Punishment for violations – Candidates opening ballot bags unauthorized need to be prosecuted
- 12) Absentee/Early ballots counted no more than 1 day before election
- 13) Multi-Partisan election observers:
 - a. Allow each town or County committee to appoint one person to observe:
 - i. the counting of ballots prior to election day
 - ii. Operation of procedures on election day
 - iii. Counting of ballots after polls close
 - b. Current JP Process still allows for purely partisan elections – need to limit slots per party
