

The following security protocol is in regard to the scheduled rally of Rising Tide Vermont and others on 6/22 through 6/24. Since many law enforcement/security groups will be dealing with this situation, it is necessary to agree on a list of prohibited acts.

1. No vehicles of any type (including agricultural vehicles) on pavers or lawn.
2. Do not fasten banners or nail signs to trees, posts, cannons or buildings, etc.
3. No large tents without prior approval.
4. All trash must be disposed of in an existing trash container or taken away.
5. Keep people and animals out of flower beds.
6. No climbing in the trees or other structures.
7. Any holes made in the ground or pavement need to be refilled.
8. The lawn may not be used for commercial purposes -- no vendors are allowed to sell their wares on the lawn.
9. Chalk and candle wax must be kept off the granite walks, steps, etc. Any cleanup of chalk or wax will be arranged by the Department and billed to the organization using the lawn.
10. During normal business hours, sound/music/noise must be kept to a level that will not disrupt/distract business in the nearby office buildings.
11. No firearms, explosives, dangerous weapons or components to fabricate such devices whether in open or concealed possession in State facilities.
12. No destroying, defacing, or damaging State property.
13. No stealing or unlawfully removing State property.
14. No breach of the peace which impedes or disrupts the orderly conduct of State business.
15. No soliciting, panhandling, or vending.
16. No displaying or distribution of commercial advertising.
17. No sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances without a physician's prescription.
18. No pets or animals in State buildings. Pets and animals are not allowed to "run at large" on State property.
19. No actions that would create an unsanitary and/or unsafe condition on State property to include not properly removing animal waste.
20. No open flames on State property to include any type of grill or cooking devise that uses an open flame.
