Governor, Lt. Governor, State and Business Leaders Encourage Vermonters to Pitch In for the 44th Annual Green Up Day

Governor Peter Shumlin and Lt. Governor Phil Scott, along with state, community and business leaders, town coordinators and volunteers, will hold a press conference on the State House steps Tuesday, asking Vermonters to join them outside for the 44th annual Green Up Day next month. During this annual tradition, started by Governor Deane C. Davis in 1970, volunteers will help clean up about 13,100 miles of road on Saturday, May 3, collecting over 40,000 bags of trash.

Speakers at Tuesday's press conference include: Governor Peter Shumlin, Lt. Governor Phil Scott, Green Up Vermont President Melinda Mieux, Mary Powell, President and CEO of signature corporate sponsor Green Mountain Power. Other key corporate sponsors, Green Up Day local coordinators, SerVermont, and AmeriCorps members will also be in attendance.
