### **Campaign Finance Deadline Today**

Montpelier, VT- Today is the deadline for all candidates, state political parties, and political committees who have made expenditures or received contributions of \$500 or more to file their campaign finance reports with the office of the Secretary of State. The filing date is normally July 15<sup>th</sup>, but when that date falls on a Sunday, the deadline moves to the next business day.

Candidates for the state senator or state representative must also file their reports with the clerk of the candidates' respective senate or house district (the same clerk where the candidate files their nominating petitions).

This is also the last day for US Congressional candidates to file FEC quarterly reports for the July quarter (April 1- June 30).

"We would like to remind candidates and parties that they will need to file their campaign finance disclosure reports on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month from now until the November election," stated Condos.

Early voting also starts today for the August 28<sup>th</sup> statewide primary for the nomination of all major party candidates for all offices to be voted for in November.

Town Clerks have already sent out absentee ballots to all overseas/military voters who have requested them and will continue to fill those requests as they come in. Civilians may come in from now until August 27<sup>th</sup> to vote early in the town clerks office or they may request an absentee ballot be emailed to them.
