Independent schools ...

- Are any school not operated by a public school district;
- Have a distinct educational mission, often a mission that differs in part from that of public schools;
- Are independently governed, usually by a board of trustees;
- Are supported by a combination of tuition payments, charitable contributions and endowment revenue.

What is VISA?

The Vermont Independent Schools Association is a non-profit organization of pre-K, elementary, middle and secondary schools organized to support and advance independent education in Vermont. It does so by:

- Working to foster and preserve schools' independence and the rights of parents to educate their children in the schools of their choice;
- Encouraging collaboration among member schools and cooperation with other educational organizations for the benefit of Vermont's students;
- Serving as a non-partisan advocate for Vermont's independent schools to the state government, Agency of Education, and the broader Vermont community.
