Secretary of State Jim Condos to Host Media Roundtable on Vermont Elections

Montpelier, VT- Vermont Secretary of State Jim Condos and Director of Elections Will Senning will host a media roundtable discussion regarding the elections that are well under way in Vermont and culminate on Tuesday, November 8. Among the topics discussed will be a response to the recent national discourse around elections security, fraud, and integrity.

Secretary Condos would like to use this opportunity to assure Vermonters that our elections are nonpartisan, transparent, and secure and address any questions about Vermont's elections. The roundtable discussion will take place on Tuesday, November 1st at 11:00am in the Secretary of State's Office.

This event is open to the public. The Secretary of State's Office will begin with a short presentation covering the following topics:

- Voter registration deadlines
- Accessibility of Vermont Elections
- Election day procedures and walk through
- Polling place security and rules
- Security of election systems
- Voter fraud
- Election night reporting

Following the presentation, the Secretary of State's Office will host an open format question and answer session.
