Darren,
I was about to send you a public records request relating to the continued sale of SPEED RECs. Rather than make you guys collect a bunch of stuff that I then have to read, I'd rather just ask you.
During the H.40 hearings in HNRE, somebody asked if just repealing SPEED wouldn't eliminate the taint of double-counting SPEED RECs. That is, if we repealed SPEED, wouldn't that be sufficient to enable the continued sale of Vermont RECs to states like Connecticut?
Chairman Klein shot the idea down, suggesting that Connecticut actually required Vermont to enact an RPS in order for REC sales to continue.
Have other New England states ever said that Vermont must establish an RPS in order for them to continue buying RECs from Vermont?
